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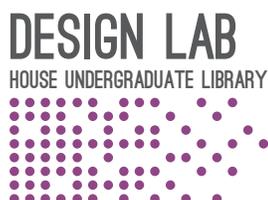

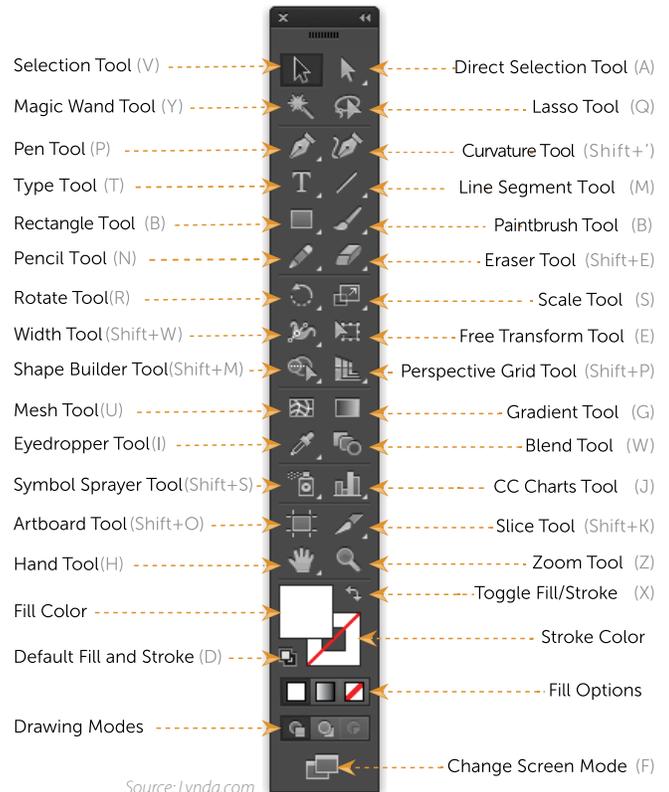

## File Formats

- AI** To create an editable Illustrator file
- SVG** Vector format for use on the web
- EPS** Vector format, able to embed in MS Office programs
- PDF** Preserves vector format; most accessible file format (provide PDFs to printers for professional printing)

# Illustrator I

## Lesson Outline

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Navigate to: [skillful.web.unc.edu](http://skillful.web.unc.edu) to download the images needed for this workshop.

### Create a new document and set up your graphics.

1. Size: 11" by 8.5" (landscape)
2. Place the mountains.png (File > Place). Resize the graphic.

### Image Trace

1. Select mountains graphic and choose Window-> Image Trace then play with the settings. I used Black & White; Threshold 127; Paths, corners and noise set to 100%
2. Select the Ellipse shape tool and draw a circle over the treeline.
3. With both objects selected, right-click and choose Make Clipping Mask. Double-click so as to move the treeline around within the mask.
4. Click outside the treeline and select the circle. Ctrl+C to copy the circle. Double-click outside the artwork and then Ctrl+B to paste behind, make the circle black. Ctrl+F to paste another circle, making it white and resize it.
5. Adjust the treeline to fit within the circles.

### Adding Text

1. Using Type Tool add text on screen, move it t where you want it. Adjust leading and tracking.
2. When done, select Type->Create Outlines.
3. Distort the type using Object -> Envelope Distort->Make with Warp

### Color your graphic

1. Select the individual shapes and choose your colors.
2. Select your type objects and change the colors.

### Pathfinder tool

1. Type the text "2017" and Convert to Outlines. Cut the text.
2. Double-click on the treeline to isolate the image.
3. Ctrl+F to paste 2017 in front of the treeline.
4. Select both the treeline and the 2017.
5. Choose Pathfinder tool to knock the type out of the green shape by choosing Minus Front (with both the treeline and the 2017 selected).

### Torn edges border

6. Select the smaller circle, copy and paste in front of the trees.
7. Switch to no fill, white outline. Adjust stroke size.
8. Choose Effect-> Distort & Transform ->Roughen.
