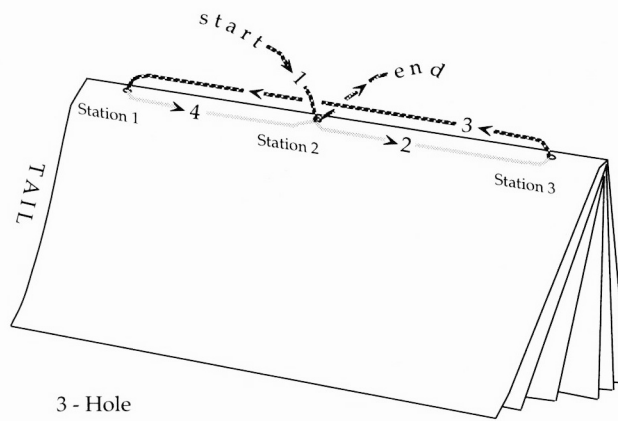


3-hole pamphlet binding



REVIEW or CONDENSED PROCEDURE

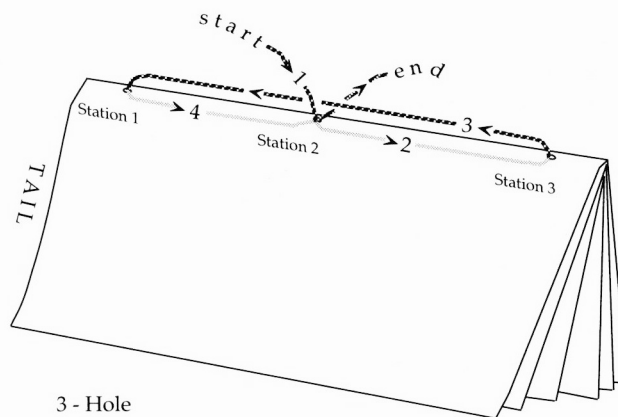
This description starts and ends on the mountain peak.

1. Go through station 2 to the inside. Leave 4" of loose thread hang on the outside of the spine.
2. Proceed on the inside to station 3. Go through to outside. Pull, reducing loose end of thread to 1-1/2".
3. Proceed along the spine, to station 1. Go through to inside.
4. Proceed on the inside to station 2. Go through to outside of the spine. Tie knot around the stitch on the spine.

*Thread needs to be 2x the height of the book, plus a couple of inches.
